## Priya Sarathy joins Maryland Legal Aid as new Chief Financial Officer

Priya joins Maryland Legal Aid as an experienced CFO. Most recently, she served as Deputy CFO for the Friendship Public Charter School District in Washington, D.C. with a budget of \$2.1 billion. Sarathy has worked primarily in the nonprofit and government sectors where she has both planned and managed large, complex budgets involving federal, state, and private grants and contracts.

Sarathy earned a Master of Business Administration in Finance and Marketing from Michigan State University. Prior to her most recent position in Washington, D.C., Sarathy served as the CFO for Lovell Government Services, and the Operations and Management Consultant Manager for the Florida Department of Education, where she continued to excel in creating and managing budgets for government and private agencies. In her time as a consultant manager for the Florida Department of Education, she developed their legislative budget request, and monitored positions and funding for K-12 schools, Office of Student and Financial Assistance (OSFA) and private colleges.

Sarathy's commitment to community service is long-standing. After serving for years as a Public Relations Liaison and Disaster Action Team Leader for the American Red Cross, she received an award for Best Volunteer.
