Maryland Legal Aid Partners with Baltimore Gas & Electric (BGE) to Host an Expungement Clinic

BALTIMORE, MARYLAND, (October 6, 2023) – Maryland Legal Aid (MLA) is partnering with BGE/Exelon to host an Expungement Clinic on Thursday, October 19, 2023. Individuals with a criminal history will have an opportunity to be advised by legal professionals and have petitions prepared on site to have eligible items removed from their record. This one-on-one expungement assistance can be life-changing for the vast number of people who qualify.

In addition, advisors will be on site to share energy assistance information and provide feedback on individual's resumes to assist with job seeking efforts.
